The articles went through at least five major revisions prior to their finalization. The Thirty-nine articles were finalized in 1571 and incorporated into the Book of Common Prayer. Although not the end of the struggle between Catholic and Protestant monarchs and citizens, the book helped to standardize the English language, and was to have a lasting effect on religion in the United Kingdom, and elsewhere through its wide use.
