

Excerpt from The Locomotive, Vol. 3 A few minutes before 5 o clock on Sunday morning, Nov. 13, 1881, ten boilers exploded at the Salt and Lumber Manufactory of Hamilton, McClure Co., situated on the Saginaw River in the town of Zilwankee, Mich. Four men who were on duty in the fire-room at the time were instantly killed, and property variously estimated from \$20,000 to \$25,000 damaged or destroyed. The ten boilers were of the horizontal tubular pattern, in a one-story boiler-house apart from the other buildings. No. 1 boiler was set singly, next to that a battery of four, Nos. 2, 3, 4, and 5; a second battery contained five, Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10; each battery having but one furnace for all, with suitable fire doors for each boiler. Each of these boilers were 50 inches in diameter by 21 feet long, of 5/10 iron originally, but since considerably thinned in places, single riveted. The single boiler was 56 inches in diameter by 13 feet long - 5/10 iron. These boilers were arranged to feed in each...
