R. 4864) to reduce taxation, to provide revenue for the Government, and for other purposes - Mr. Cockran said: That brings me back to the proposition of the gentleman from Maine. I say, that the importation of \$250,000,000 worth of goods can not occur unless you export \$250,000,000 worth of goods to pay for them. You must pay for them in some form or another, because nobody has suggested in this House as a possibility in actual life the presentation, as a gift, of a large quantity of goods by one nation to another. I except from the operation of that remark the gentleman from Massachusetts, who is not bound by the ordinary rules of controversy or the ordinary limitations of common sense. [Laughter.] Mr. Walker. Mr. Chairman, there has been no epithet that could be...
