

It is not likely that further exactions will be placed on banks. The situation as to corporations at large has not been developed. There has been a disposition to relieve mortgages from taxation under the General Property Tax Law, and to make a tax for State purposes instead. It is notable that all the new taxes in sight will go to the State, and that, as respects trust companies, local taxes will be remitted excepting on real estate owned.
